Funding Information Network (FIN) consists of more than 400 libraries, community foundations, and other nonprofit resource centers, where we provide free access to Foundation Directory Online and conduct trainings for local communities.

GuideStar Charity Check allows users to confirm a nonprofit's eligibility for grants and contributions.

GuideStar Database includes data on 1.9 million 501c3 entities, making it easier to understand who they are and what they do. Donors can explore organizations and the issues that they want to support, while nonprofit leaders can benchmark their organizations against their peers.
