Getting Started

- Review demographic data of your community
- Consult your institution's strategic plan, collection policy, etc.
- Create your own collection plan and vision statement
- Reach out to patrons, community orgs, and other local libraries for input, book donations
- Secure funding: library budget, support from Friends or community to jumpstart collection

Topics to consider

- Prepare for technical processing challenges
- Develop a physical presence with appropriate signage and displays
- Create a labelling/shelving system that works for you and your patrons
- Explore possible crossover with ELL services and programming
- Consider policy for accepting or rejecting donation of materials
