



- Hearing loss over 35db and other physical disabilities present
- Late-Deafened
 - https://mn.gov/deaf-hard-of-hearing/hearing-loss/adults/late-deafened/
- Hard of Hearing
 - aka Hearing Impaired, but this is considered to be an insensitive label.
 - It means this person has a tested 35db or greater loss of hearing.
- CODA/SODA
 - Child of Deaf Adults and/or Sibling of Deaf Adults






