Project Background

Detroit Area Library Network

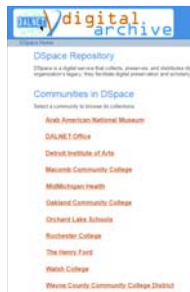
- DALNET is a community of libraries working together since 1985
- Currently 17 members, including academic, public, school, and special libraries
- Currently maintaining and supporting Alma Library Services Platform with Primo Discovery Catalog and DSpace Digital Repository

Getting Started

- 4 members plus DALNET Office
- Initially grant-funded, now part of annual budget
- Now includes 10 members in various stages of implementation



Defining Our Needs

- Formed the Digital Archive Repository Task-Force (DART)

- System Needs:

- Digital file formats
- Local branding
- Metadata standards
- OAI-PMH compliant
- Cost and resource use

Our Selection: DSpace

- Open source with large community of users
- Locally hosted
- Harvestable Dublin Core Metadata
- Hosts any file type
- Search full-text OCR (optical character recognition) and metadata
- Image thumbnails
- Public and private collections



System Hosting

- Hosted by member University of Detroit Mercy
- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with consortium
- Startup costs included equipment and physical plant infrastructure
- System configuration and maintenance
- Ancillary systems (i.e. domain name, handle.net, etc.)

Profiling the System

- Profiling forms for constructing *Communities*
- Profiling forms for constructing *Collections*
- Defined forms for Dublin Core fields for each collection
- Forms for defining system access for collection work (i.e. read, submit, edit, approve)
- Institutional branding and CSS



Making a Demo Collection

- Detroit *Plaindealer*
 - A weekly syndicated African-American newspaper from the late 1800s
 - On microfilm at the Library of Michigan
 - Digitized into OCR PDFs by Central Michigan University Clarke Historical Library's *Michigan Digital Newspaper Project*

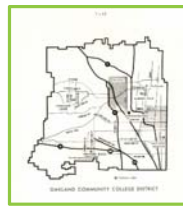
Training and Support

- Functions as DART successor for making system proposals and decisions



DALNET Digital Lab

- Equipment can be used in the DALNET office or checked out
- Ability to convert slides, negatives, VHS tapes, audiocassette tapes, and records to digital files
- Members can propose new equipment purchases and seek DALNET funding

How Are We Using DSpace?



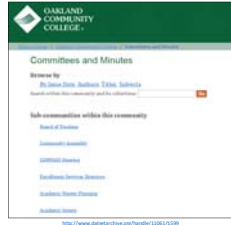
Collection Access

- Highlighting unique collections and treasures
- Bringing together physically separate collections
- Storage for digital files



Building Institutional Repositories

- Public and private access collections
- Used by the library to support institutional endeavors
- A digital space to collect and organize access to institutional memory



Increasing Accessibility

- Student projects and publications
- Making restricted materials accessible
 - Fragile
 - Rare
 - Closed Stacks
- Supplementing print collections with global access for researchers and the casual visitor



Marketing & Promotion

- Curating virtual collections for special events
- Using digital collections for donor relations
- Promoting the library by highlighting its special collections



Future Plans

- Harvest DSpace collections for access in member discovery catalogs
- Make the collections available through DPLA
- Adoption by more members
- Continued building of collections
- Digitization Work Days
