Following instructions provided in the Breakout challenge, the Breakout facilitator (teacher, parent, corporate trainer) sets up the Breakout room: hiding keys, boxes and inserting any required mystery items.



Step 2

The facilitator invites the players into the room and introduces the story, explains the rules, and answers any questions.



Step 3

Players have a fixed amount of time to solve a series of challenges, riddles, and mysteries in order to "break out."

Each game is designed so that players are immersed in the experience and are racing against the clock to break out before time expires.



Step 4

The game facilitator reviews how the team did and reveals what they may have missed if they were unable to solve the puzzle mysteries and breakout.

The team takes a picture with the failure or success sign to share with their friends.
