- The school district and the public library share the same geographic boundaries.
- Public library use is a lifelong skill. The school is fostering this skill by hosting visits by the public library staff.
- Public and school libraries share the same goals like digital and information literacy, access to information.
- School library staff and public library staff have complimentary skills. The
 school staff knows about reading levels and curriculum standards; while the
 public library staff is more involved with the teen social and entertainment
 needs and focus more on reading for pleasure.
- To help optimize the Chrome books that the school provide the students and the public libraries eBook collection a partnership is a mutually beneficial.
- Studies show that access to books is an important part of a youth's development, a partnership increases this access.

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
