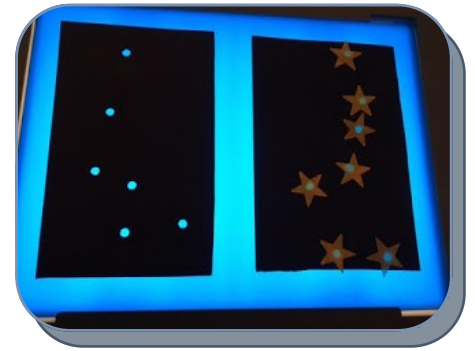


Sensory Story Time Favorites
